SPORT DEVELOPMENT / PE ACTION PLAN 2021-22

with sports funding allocation (£19,590 and £6,284.19 carried forward from 2021-22)

September 2021: This is a working document and will be amended as sporting provision is adapted and adjusted throughout the year.

The aim of this document is to:

- develop or add to the PE, physical activity and sport activities
- build capacity and capability within the school to ensure that improvements made now will benefit pupils joining the school in future years

For 2020-21, the total expenditure was £16,450.81 and therefore, £6,284.19 will be carried forward into the next academic year (2021-22).

As a result of the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak, the Department for Education took steps to relax the ring-fencing arrangements for the PE and sport premium in the 2019 to 2020 academic year to allow any unspent grant to be carried forward into the 2020 to 2021 academic year. On 17 June 2021, the Education Secretary announced a further relaxation of ring-fencing arrangements for the PE and sport premium. This will allow any unspent grant to be carried forward into the 2021 to 2022 academic year. At Woodhouse, any under-spends (£6,284.19) will be carried forward into the Sport Development / PE Action Plan 2021-22 and will be spent in full by 31 July 2022 in line with the DfE guidance
