#### New Starter Open Afternoon – Tuesday 20 November – 1.45pm

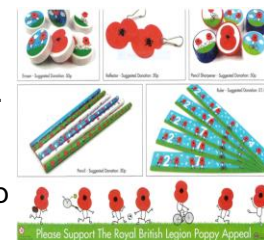
