


Dear Parent/Carers,

In Literacy, we have read the book 'Traction Man' and started to think about ways to describe heroes in stories. We will continue with our work on Traction Man next week. If the children have any super hero stories that they would like to bring in, they will have the opportunity to share them with the class and 'magpie' any ideas for their own writing. The children were excited to use the action figures brought in from home to create their scenes and were very successful in using them to act out the different scenarios. They then drew comic strips and wrote speech bubbles to show what each character would say. Next week, we will be describing the characters and what they did.



In Numeracy, we have continued to explore division but moved on from sharing to a new method of grouping. We then went on show the link between multiplication and division by creating a 'Family of 4'.

In PE lessons, we are beginning our new 'Dance' unit. This will be linked to our CCL topic 'Transport'. Over the next 6 weeks, we will be looking at different types of dance, learning new movements and how to match movement to music.

On Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> March, we will be launching our new topic 'Transport'. We would therefore like the children to bring their bikes/scooters to school on this day should they wish to. Your child **MUST** bring a well-fitting helmet with them in order to ride their bike/scooter. Unfortunately, if they do not bring a helmet, they will not be able to ride their bike/scooter. Children will come to school in their school uniforms as normal but we would advise that they wear comfortable clothing (i.e. trousers and sensible shoes). All children will be supervised by an adult when riding their bike. For the safety of others, children must **not** ride their bikes on the school premises before or after school. Please park the bikes/scooters in the KS1 playground (on the football pitch outside 2B's classroom exit) where staff will be waiting and pupils should bring the helmets into the classroom. If you have any information linked to our transport topic or have any photographs of you on your bike, please send them into school to assist us with our learning.
