
Dear Parents/Carers,

In Literacy this week, we have been recapping the 2 and 3 letters sounds and practised finding these in words. We have learnt the tricky star words '**were**' and '**come**' and revised the other tricky star words taught so far. We have also been recapping the phase 2 and 3 high frequency words and practising recognising these words by sight. We will continue to work on the tricky two and three letter sounds. All pupils should have brought home an information sheet to let you know how well they are doing with phase 2 and 3, if anyone is unsure of their child's next step please let us know so we can support you.

In Maths, the children have been learning about different times of the day and have had a go at making o'clock times using the clocks. We have been busy sequencing the different things that happen within a typical day and have introduced language such as first, next, then, after that and finally. All pupils should have brought home a feedback sheet to inform you of their progress and next steps for numeracy and literacy. Again, if you would like any help with supporting your child's learning at home then please ask.

During our Enquiry Learning sessions we have been learning about Mother's Day, painting portraits, planting and making cards.

Many thanks to the parents who have helped to support the children's understanding in our 'world of work' topic. Next week we will be continuing our research into the different jobs and hobbies in our local community and further afield.
