## European Parliamentary Election

We have been notified this week that, in the event of the UK still being a member of the EU on 23<sup>rd</sup> May, the school will be required as a polling station. Should this be the case, school will be closed to all pupils on this day. We appreciate the inconvenience this may cause but the governors and leadership of the school have taken the decision that in order to safeguard all of our pupils this is unavoidable. We will provide further information as we receive it but due to the uncertainty of the Brexit situation, we are unable to make a final decision at this stage. As a community school, the local authority determines which buildings it uses for polling purposes and, as such, we have no say in the matter. The Council is currently undertaking a statutory review of polling districts, places and stations and is inviting views from the public.
