


Dear Parent/Carers,

In Monday's Literacy lesson, we received a video message and letter from the evil villain 'Poisonous Dish Cloth'. He explained that he had captured our Traction Man! The children were very shocked and decided that something must be done to find and rescue Traction Man. Our best idea was to make some 'Wanted' and 'Missing' posters to put up around school in the hope that some other children in the school may be able to help us too. She couldn't see very much from her bed so she had a mirror placed on the ceiling so that she could see herself. Next week, we will have a go at drawing our own self-portraits in the same way so watch this space!
