


Reception Newsletter

In Literacy this week, we have been busy writing 'Wanted' posters to help us find the Easter Bunny. We thought about what the Easter Bunny looks like, gave a description, where he was last seen and a reward for whoever finds him.

In Maths, the children have been working practically with Easter eggs to find two different parts of a whole and found all the different ways of making number 7. They then recorded the numbers down in a whole-part-part model.



During our Enquiry Learning sessions we have been learning about Easter and why some people celebrate this time of year. We have enjoyed completing Easter activities, going on an Easter egg hunt and shared Hot Cross Buns during our snack time together.
