

Dear Parent / Carer,

Firstly, we would like to say thank you to the children for being so well behaved and polite on our trip to Shibden Hall. We had lots of fun learning about 'The Great Fire of London' and having a go at putting out a pretend fire. The children found it fascinating to look at the different buildings and transport at Shibden Hall.

We are sending out this week's letter on Thursday due to the School Summer Fayre taking place tomorrow straight after school. This means that you can keep your child's Reading Packet and bag at home tomorrow so that they don't have as much to carry if they are staying with you to enjoy the fayre.

In Literacy this week, we have focussed on preparing the children for the Phonics Check which will take place next week. We will let you know if they have passed the Check before the end of term. If they do not pass, they will re-take the Check in June 2020.

In Numeracy, we have continued to explore finding half of an amount or quantity. Using the bar model, children have been able to find two equal parts of a whole number. Next week, we will be using known addition and subtraction facts (within 20) to solve missing number problems.

In CCL lessons, we have completed the painting of our Hundertwasser houses and they are now brightening up our classroom walls. The children enjoyed mixing Primary colours to make secondary colours whilst painting their houses.
