


Dear Parent/Carers,

In Literacy, we have read the book 'Horrid Henry's Homework' and thought about how he would feel and what he would be thinking at each stage in the story. From this, we then wrote a character description talking about what Henry looks like (appearance) and what he is like as a person (personality). The children then thought of their own pranks and wrote about Henry's 'Day of Mischief'. There were some great ideas of pranks that he could play such as taps being left running in the bathroom, salt being swapped for sugar in the kitchen, disgusting creatures being slipped into Perfect Peter's bed and many more!



In Numeracy, we returned to our work on telling the time and could tell that lots of children have been practising their time telling skills during the holidays. We also recapped the properties of 2D and 3D shapes and compared shapes to each other by answering questions such as:

What is the same? What is different?



We ensured that we used correct mathematical vocabulary (e.g. faces, vertices, edges, curved, flat) to explain in a concise and clear manner. This is a skill the children have grappled with which we will continue to practise.

In Science this week, we have been investigating what plants need to make them grow well. We have planned and carried out an experiment to find out what different conditions do to a plant (e.g. removing light, no water). We have also compared seeds and bulbs and have planted cress seeds to find out about the effect of temperature on growth.
