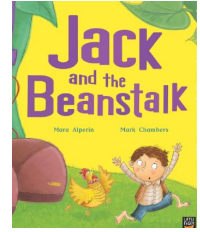
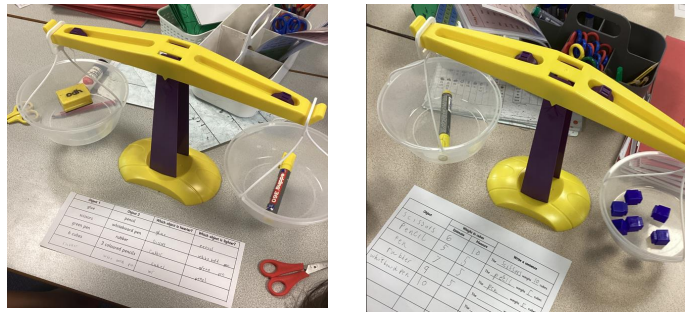


Dear Parent / Carer,

This week in English, we have been retelling the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. The children worked hard to include some ambitious vocabulary in their writing and really enjoyed developing their ideas.



In Maths, we have been exploring weight and mass using balance scales. Using the balance scales, the children were able to compare heavier and lighter classroom items.



In RE, we have been learning about how we welcome new life. The children explored different ways that families and religions celebrate the arrival of a new baby.
