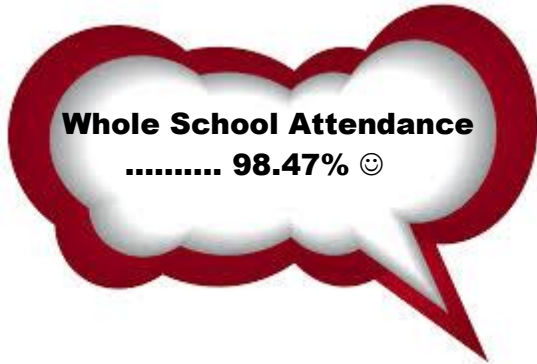
Calderdale Local Offer Live
