In Literacy this week, we have been continuing with our text based unit. We have continued to read and look at *The Worst Witch* – completing some shared writing and some independent writing. We celebrated 'Poetry Day' on Thursday by keeping with the theme of *The Worst Witch* and creating our own potions. We then put these potions into a rhyme and performed these in groups.

In Numeracy this week, we have been looking at ordering numbers in different ways eg on a number line, using numbers written as words, using money and using measures. We have also learnt the meaning of ascending and descending and how to remember these meanings when ordering.

We had a brilliant afternoon on Monday starting to sew our puppets. The children have been able to put their pre-learnt sewing skills to the test with the help of the adults who volunteered to help.
