

Dear Parents/Carers,

In Literacy this week, we have created and performed our own version of – The Sound Collector – by Roger McGough. The children have based their own poems on sounds that they can hear in and around school. To help us write the poem we learned about - **Onomatopoeia** which means - a word that describes a sound and actually mimics the sound of the object or action it refers to when it is spoken.



Next term, we will be focusing on a non-fiction unit of work.

In Numeracy, the children have continued adding and subtracting a single digit number to / from a 3 digit number while crossing the boundary. We looked at using the partitioning model and number line method and used these methods to help us solve more complex problems. In order to help us with these methods, we have needed to make sure we are fluent with our number bonds to 10.

Our puppets work has now come to an end as we have performed our puppet shows. In groups the children retold a well-known story and performed brilliantly to Year 1 children who were a fantastic audience!

We are looking forward to starting our new CCL topic after the holiday which is 'Around the World'. This will involve using maps and atlases to learn about different countries and continents.

Finally, we are very pleased with the effort and enthusiasm from Year 3 children and we are looking forward to more of this after the holidays.
