

Dear Parents/Carers,

In English this week, we have completed our non-fiction unit of work. We have read fact files about England and France. The children have used non-fiction features to help us to find information and key facts, for example using subheadings and titles. They then organised and wrote some facts from a range of bullet points related to a country / city and its culture. They have grouped together relevant information and have been encouraged to use interesting opening words in their sentences. Next week, we will begin a new a new unit of work linked to 'Quests'.

In Numeracy, the children have been subtracting 2 digit numbers from 3 digit numbers using exchanging when crossing the boundary.

Eg 340 – 80

We have looked at different strategies to answer these questions such as: counting backwards, using sticks and bricks and showing this on a number line.

We are really pleased with how the children have been using their knowledge of number bonds to 100 to help them answer these questions.

This week is anti-bullying week and we have enjoyed exploring the theme 'Change Starts with Us'. We have reflected on and celebrated our differences and equality and how individually and collectively we can take action to prevent bullying.



In our French lessons this week, we have been learning how to say different colours in French. We have been working really hard on our pronunciation.
