In English, we have practised spelling the days of the week and writing high five sentences containing these words. We have also written about all of the explorers that we have learnt about this half term. After the holiday, our learning will be based around the book **Beegu** by Alexis Deacon.

In Phonics lessons this week, we have revised all of the Phase 5 sounds and practised reading and spelling words containing these graphemes.

This week in Maths, we have been doubling numbers. We looked at many different representations of doubles:



$4 + 4 = \underline{\quad}$

three add three = $\underline{\quad}$

double 8 = $\underline{\quad}$

$6 + 6 = \underline{\quad}$

After the holiday, we will be sharing and finding half and then linking this to division.

In CCL, the children designed their own flags. They then learnt how to use a running stitch and sewed their design onto a piece of Binca. Thank you to all of the parents, grandparents and carers who came to join us for the Open Door session. It was lovely to see everyone helping their children to sew and many of you learning how to do a running stitch too!
