

Dear Parents/Carers,

In Literacy this week, we have been looking for the trickier 2 and 3 letter sounds in words and practised writing these words, trying to remember to write the letters in the correct order. We have recapped all of our phase 3 tricky star words and have now started to learn our next set of tricky star words. This week we have taught the tricky words 'said' and 'so'. Please continue to encourage your child to practise reading and spelling the phase 2 and 3 tricky star words taught so far.

In Numeracy the children have been practising adding numbers of objects together to find the total and then recording their calculations using jottings to help them. We have worked with the numicon in class to find as many ways as we could to make 10 and enjoyed learning our 'number bonds to 10 song' to help us remember all the numbers that pair up to make 10.

In our topic, we have enjoyed an exciting 'World Book Day' session as we enjoyed sharing our favourite books from home with our Year 6 buddies. As part of our World Book Day celebrations there will shortly be a Bedtime Story section of the school website so that you can watch and listen as different teachers read different books.



Next week, we are looking forward to welcoming visitors to learn about the wide world of work and the different hobbies that some people have.
