


Year 2 Newsletter 2

In English this week, we have been learning about different types of words (nouns and verbs), as well as investigating the features of instructional texts. Top Grammar Tips for your child:


Nouns – people, places, animals, objects

Verbs – action words, often end in ‘ing’, also: have, be, is

Note: adjectives can also end in –ing e.g. “our **exciting** launch day”

We are now encouraging most children to join their handwriting whenever they write. Please make sure your child does not join any capital letters but the rest of their letters should now be joined. Some children are finding this tricky so any practise at home would be really helpful.

In Maths this week, the children have been learning how to write numbers as words as well as numerals. We have also been exploring 2-digit numbers by making them out of sticks and bricks and putting them into tens and ones/units columns, to show their place value.



We are very much looking forward to our exciting launch day next week, especially now the children know that in CCL we will be learning all about different celebrations.
