

## 1. Bubble lockdown – information for parents

If your child's bubble has to isolate, we will provide the following to ensure that your child still has access to teaching and learning. It is expected that children will complete the work that is set by their teacher and that work is emailed to the teacher via 2Email on Purple Mash. Guides on how to use Purple Mash can be found on the school website in the Home Learning section

Work will be set for pupils as outlined below and it will be emailed to you by 5pm the day before it is due to be completed (on Fridays for Monday lessons) to provide sufficient time to view the lessons/print sheets as necessary. Feedback for core subjects will be communicated via Purple Mash and pupils will have the opportunity to discuss their Maths and English work with teachers daily (see below).

Subject	Offer
English	<p><b>EYFS:</b> Each day, pupils will be sent a different link to a 'Mr Thorne' phonics video. In addition to this, each week, teachers will send the following work via 2email on Purple Mash:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- List of tricky star words</li> <li>- Links for Ebooks</li> <li>- A handwriting sheet</li> <li>- A video of the teacher reading a story</li> <li>- English 2Dos will be set on Purple Mash (phonics, reading and spelling)</li> </ul> <p><b>Years 1-6:</b> Each day, pupils will be sent (via 2email/blog):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- An introductory lesson video, recorded by a teacher</li> <li>- Lesson slides</li> <li>- Worksheets/resources if relevant</li> </ul> <p>Pupils will be expected to send work to the teacher via 2email on Purple Mash. Teachers will provide feedback via 2email and online video tutorials will be available each afternoon (teachers will confirm times and send a link to pupils via 2 email)</p> <p><b>Weekly spelling test</b> Each week, spellings will be emailed via 2email on Purple Mash.</p> <p><b>2Dos set each week</b> Each week, teachers will set a range of English 2Dos on Purple Mash.</p> <p><b>Feedback for all year groups</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Feedback for 2Dos will be provided to pupils via Purple Mash.</li> <li>- Pupils will be expected to complete English work and send to the teacher by 1pm.</li> <li>- Teachers will provide pupils with an opportunity to discuss English lessons/work each afternoon, once they have completed their morning lesson.</li> <li>- Teachers will deliver tutorials on Teams each afternoon if pupils wish to discuss their work.</li> <li>- Once they have been given feedback, pupils can have another attempt at their work and email it to the teacher by 4pm that day.</li> </ul>
Maths	<p><b>EYFS:</b> Each day, pupils will be sent (via 2email on Purple Mash) a link to a White Rose Maths Hub lesson (these tend to include practical activities) and also a link to CBeebies 'number blocks.' Each week, teachers will set 2Dos on Purple Mash that cover appropriate fluency skills.</p> <p><b>Years 1-6:</b> Each day, pupils will be sent (via 2email on Purple Mash):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- An introductory lesson video recorded by the teacher</li> <li>- A link to the relevant lesson and documents on White Rose Maths (these will include lesson slides, a worksheet and an answer sheet)</li> </ul>

	<p><b>Fluency activities on PM</b> Each week, teachers will set 2Dos that cover appropriate fluency skills.</p> <p><b>Feedback for all year groups</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Feedback for 2Dos will be provided to pupils via Purple Mash.</li> <li>- Pupils will be expected to complete Maths work and send to the teacher by 1pm.</li> <li>- Teachers will provide pupils with an opportunity to discuss Maths lessons/work each afternoon, once they have completed their morning lesson.</li> <li>- Teachers will deliver tutorials on Teams each afternoon if pupils wish to discuss their work.</li> <li>- Once they have been given feedback, pupils can have another attempt at their work and email it to the teacher by 4pm that day.</li> </ul>
Topic lessons	<p><b>EYFS:</b> Weekly, a planned play mat that incorporates understanding the world, expressive arts and design and technology will be sent via 2email on Purple Mash.</p> <p><b>Year 1-6:</b> Each week, pupils will be emailed an activity mat that will direct pupils to activities/lessons for the following subjects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Science</li> <li>• History or Geography</li> <li>• RESPECT</li> <li>• PE</li> <li>• RE</li> <li>• Computing</li> <li>• Art or DT</li> <li>• French (KS2 only)</li> </ul> <p><b>Feedback for all year groups:</b> Teachers will provide feedback for topic lessons via 2email/when marking 2Dos.</p>

## 2. Individual pupil absences (for a confirmed positive test result)

If your child lives with someone who has tested positive or has been advised to self-isolate by Test and Trace, provision will be as outlined below:

Subject	Offer
English	<p><b>EYFS:</b> Staff will email limited lesson slides and resources that are being taught in class. They will be sent via 2Email on Purple Mash. Pupils will also be set 2Dos for phonics/spelling. They can also access activities of their choice by selecting the icons shown on the homepage.</p> <p><b>Year 1-6:</b> Staff will email <b>limited</b> lesson slides and resources that are being taught in class. They will be sent via 2Email on Purple Mash.  Pupils will have been set weekly spellings which they can practise. They can also access activities of their choice by selecting the icons shown on the homepage.</p>
Maths	<p><b>EYFS - Year 6:</b> Staff will email <b>limited</b> lesson slides and resources that are being taught in class. They will be sent via 2Email on Purple Mash.</p>

	Pupils will also be able to access activities on Purple Mash of their choice by selecting the icons shown on the homepage or access TTRockStars using their log-in.
Other subjects (inc. Science, CCL, Music, RE, RESPECT, Art, MFL, DT, PE)	<p><b>EYFS – Year 6:</b></p> <p>Staff will email lessons of slides and resources which are being taught in class across the curriculum for the two weeks of isolation.</p> <p>Pupils can also access activities on Purple Mash of their choice by selecting the items shown on the homepage.</p>

### 3. Individual pupil absences (for those awaiting a test result)

Over the next few months, there will be a number of children who are awaiting test results for either themselves or a family member. Provision will be as outlined below and further details can be found in pupils' individual homework diaries.

Subject	Offer
English	<p>Pupils should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- practise their weekly spellings and Star Spellers words (statutory word lists)</li> <li>- read their reading stage book</li> <li>- complete an Accelerated Reader quiz if the child is in Year 6</li> <li>- Purple Mash activities on Serial Mash (self-selected)</li> <li>- complete a diary entry of their day</li> </ul>
Maths	<p>Pupils should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- practise their times tables on TT RockStars</li> <li>- Purple Mash activities (self-selected)</li> </ul>
CCL/Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- research their current topic and create a fact-file from this research</li> </ul>
