### **Remote Education: March 2021**

#### **Key points**

- Our remote education follows a clear sequenced curriculum which supports learners in accessing high-quality online and offline resources/ teaching videos, all linked to our curriculum expectations.
- We teach the same curriculum and use the same resources remotely as we do in school
- Children are expected to engage daily. The benefits of recorded lessons and Purple Mash is that the work is accessible at any time throughout the day to fit with the commitments of others in the family
- Parent/carers are encouraged to support their children's work to the best of their ability, encouraging them to work with good levels of concentration and enable them to maintain a regular routine
- Staff will keep a record of pupil engagement and maintain regular contact with pupils who are accessing learning remotely
- Parents and carers are expected to adhere to Parental Teams agreement (see below: emailed and displayed on the school website)
- Pupils who do not have access to the internet and disadvantaged pupils will be prioritised for access to laptops/tablets on loan from school
- Printed resources, such as textbooks and workbooks, may be provided for pupils for whom we cannot provide laptops/tablets (due to insufficient stock) or do not have access to the internet, perhaps (but not exclusively) due to safeguarding reasons
- We will work with families to support children in accessing remote/home learning without causing undue distress for our most vulnerable and complex learners

#### **Study time**

We expect that remote education (including remote teaching and independent work) will take pupils broadly the following number of hours each day:

Reception and Key Stage 1	Three hours (less for YR pupils)
Key Stage 2	Four hours

#### **Accessing remote education**

Access to remote learning is via each pupil's individual 2email account which can be accessed via Purple Mash. Pupils use this regularly in school and for homework and should be familiar with how to log in. In the event of any difficulties, parents/carers should contact the school office.

#### **Feedback**

- Pupils are requested to email their completed work by 1 pm although it is recognised that this may not be possible.
- Pupils will be invited to a daily Teams meeting and teachers will host tutorials and well-being sessions where they will provide pupils with an opportunity for verbal feedback. The Teams meetings on Fridays will involve the whole class/cohort with a focus on pupil well-being.
- Work sent in via 2email will be responded to via Purple Mash but dependent on the time of submission, this may not be on the same day. As per usual practice in school, feedback will, at times, require that the child responds to it in some way.
- Feedback for 2Dos will be provided to pupils via Purple Mash, usually by a TA.

### Parental Teams Agreement

To ensure your child's and others' safety and enjoyment of each MS Teams sessions, we expect parents and carers to adhere to the following:

- Ensure, to the best of your ability, that your child is punctual to ensure the smooth running of the session
- Ensure that your child is situated within a suitable communal quiet space within the home and that, where possible, background noise is kept to a minimum
- Ensure that your child is suitably dressed when operating the video function of a Teams call
- Ensure that your child, and all members of the household, use appropriate language at all times whilst the Teams session is live
- Ensure that the Teams link is not shared with anyone else

NB failure to comply with the above, and the school's positive behaviour expectations, could result in the removal of a pupil from a session.

<b>ENGLISH</b>	<p><b>Years 1-6:</b>            Each day pupils will be sent (via 2email):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A daily English lesson, following the sequence of learning which includes a specific task. These tasks are likely to include spelling, grammar or phonics learning</li> <li>Pupils in Year 1 will also be sent daily phonics activities</li> </ul> <p>Each week spellings will be emailed with opportunities to practise, culminating in a spelling test</p>
<b>READING</b>	<p><b>Each week</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>KS1 – One DARTS lesson will be sent within an English lesson</li> <li>KS2 - One weekly DARTS activity will be emailed on an assigned day in addition to the five daily English lessons ( It should be made clear that it is compulsory like the daily Maths and English tasks.) <b>MATHS</b>	<p><b>Years 1-6:</b> Each day pupils will be sent (via 2email):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A daily Maths lesson linked to the current sequence of learning, this may include accredited resources from external sources eg the White Rose Maths Hub, Oak Academy and will incorporate mental maths</li><li>• Fluency activities (sometimes set as 2Dos)</li></ul> <p>For KS2 pupils, a fortnightly TT Rock Stars competition will encourage and enable children to continue to practise their times table fluency.</p> <p><b>Additional resources</b> Further activities (2Dos) will be set for pupils to access on Purple Mash which link to the current sequence of learning and also enable pupils to build on and consolidate their existing knowledge</p>

**2 Individual pupil absences (for a confirmed positive test result)**

As the year group is still operating for the majority of pupils in school, teaching staff will be working in school each day with the children in attendance. Feedback on pupils' work for those in isolation will therefore be given as soon as is practically possible, but it is unlikely to be in the detail that is routinely provided in lessons. It may be that this feedback is not given always by the class teacher or even on the same day. It may be delegated to a suitably experienced support staff member to ensure manageable workload.

Parents/carers are asked to contact school by email should they require any support or adjustments to the work which has been set.

If the child self-isolating is eligible for free school meals, we would work with families to provide these during this period. Regular well-being checks will be put in place.

*\*If a child is self-isolating as a result of travelling abroad and needing to quarantine, we will only set work for the pupil if the quarantine measures were put in place whilst actually on holiday. If a family decides to travel abroad knowing that restrictions are in place on their return, we will not set work for the pupil.*

They will be sent via 2Email on Purple Mash.</p> <p>Pupils can also access activities on Purple Mash of their choice by selecting the icons shown on the homepage or access TTRock Stars using their log-in.</p>

<b>Subject</b>	<b>Offer</b>
English	Teachers will <b>not</b> provide any content of lessons taught in class but signpost these children to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- practise their weekly spellings and Star Spellers words (statutory word lists)</li><li>- read their stage book</li><li>- complete an Accelerated Reader quiz if the child is in Year 6</li><li>- Purple Mash activities on Serial Mash (self-selected)</li><li>- complete a diary entry of their day</li></ul>
Maths	Teachers will <b>not</b> provide any content of lessons taught in class but signpost these children to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- practise their times tables on TTRockStars</li><li>- Purple Mash activities (self-selected)</li></ul>
