Dear Parents/Carers,

In English this week, we continued to focus on punctuating direct speech and are gaining confidence with this. We have also been looking at a range of diary entries and discussing their key features. Next week we will be writing our own diary entry from Goldilocks' point of view.

In Maths, we have been adding and subtracting single digit numbers on to three digit numbers using different methods. Next week, we will be adding and subtracting across a boundary of 10 from two and three digit numbers.

Our DT topic 'Puppets' is nearly at an end and our puppets are almost completed. Next week we will be evaluating our designs and using our puppets to retell traditional stories together.

We have been pleased to see that many children are reading at home regularly and changing their books at least once a week- well done! Please support your child by listening to them read for at least 5 to 10 minutes each day and by ensuring they always bring their reading diary, reading packet and reading book to school each day.
