In English this week, we have been writing our own diary entry from Goldilocks' point of view. We are focusing on using capital letters and full stops correctly in an extended piece of writing. Most children can say that a capital letter comes at the beginning of a sentence and a full stop comes at the end but are sometimes finding it difficult to know when to start a new sentence or where to use a conjunction. We have done lots of focused editing together. Your child may wish to show you how they would edit the following:

I walked into the woods the woods were beautiful and I could hear the birds singing Just then I saw an old, crumbly cottage and I decided to go and knock on the door no one answered I was very interested to see what was inside so I crept in.

In Maths, we have been adding and subtracting across a boundary of 10 from two digit numbers. Next week, we will be completing some assessments and times tables activities.
