Dear Parents/Carers,

In Literacy this week, we have been practising writing the 2 and 3 letter sounds in words. We have been trying very hard to remember the order of the letter sounds such as 'light' instead of 'lghit' or 'boat' instead of 'baot' etc. Please encourage your child to remember the order of these sounds which will help them when they are writing words, captions and short sentences. This week we have learnt the phase 4 tricky star words **come** and **were**. You should have received the phase 4 word list in the children's orange high frequency word box. Please keep practising these at home.

In Numeracy, we have been recapping number bonds to 10. We have been looking at all the different ways we can make 10, using the numicon pieces to help. We have started assessing the children in their number work and you will receive a detailed feedback sheet that will include their next steps in their learning in the next couple of weeks.

During Enquiry Learning this week we have enjoyed our topic on Jobs and Hobbies. We have enjoyed looking at the different types of jobs that there are and painting what we would like to be when we grow up.
