****Classroom News****

Year 3 - In Year 3 English this week, we began a new unit of work based on the Roald Dahl text 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. We invented our own character and wrote a character description after comparing characters from this text and 'Jake Jellicoe'. In Maths, we have been converting units of measure and solving addition and subtraction problems involving mm, cm and m. We have learnt about clay sculpting techniques in Art and designed our own clay paleo-art sculptures ready for our practical clay session next week.

Year 4 - We have had a great first week back! In Maths, we have been learning how to find the perimeter and area of shapes. In English, we have started to explore stories with different dilemmas. We have been thinking about the different actions we could take when faced with a dilemma! We have also been learning about states of matter in Science. In History, we have been researching Julius Caesar.

Year 5 - We have started learning about settlements. In groups, we designed our own village full of local amenities. In Maths, we have been looking at decimals and working out when to add mentally or when to use a written method. We have also started reading our new book 'There's a Boy in the Girls' Bathroom' and we have been hot seating the central characters in the story.

Year 6 - This week, we have launched our new CCL topic by researching and creating our own 3D models of some of the Seven Wonders of the World. This tested our knowledge of 3D nets and also our perseverance and collaborative skills. In English, we have written a conversation between two characters from our new book: Sir Gawain and the Loathly Lady. In Maths, we have been learning how to find missing angles on a straight line and around a point.
