Dear Parents/Carers,


In Literacy this week, we have been focusing on spelling words with the phase 4 cluster sounds fr, bl, fl and gl and then writing captions with some of these spellings in them. We have been remembering a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop. We have also had a focus on spelling the phase 3 tricky words. Please keep practising the instant recognition of these and their spellings.

In Numeracy, we have continued our learning all about 3D shapes! We talked about their properties and used vocabulary such as: faces, edges and vertices to describe them. The children have done a great job with finding the 3D shapes in their environment and talked about their favourite shape and why. Keep having a look out in your house to see if you can spot any more shapes.

As part of our Enquiry Learning this week, we have really enjoyed our topic of 'Now I am big'. We have looked at our baby pictures and compared them to now. We have talked about what we could do then and what we can do now and the similarities and differences we could spot. We have completed some brilliant pieces of writing about this. We have also enjoyed painting self-portraits of ourselves as a baby and now. Well done everyone!
