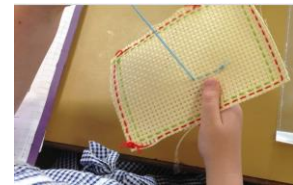


In English this week, the children have planned and written their 'Under the Sea' adventure stories about Biff, Chip and Kipper. We were really pleased with how many children were able to write high 5 sentences with accurate capital letters and full stops– well done!

In Phonics lessons this week, we have revised all of the Phase 5 sounds and practised reading and spelling words containing these graphemes.

This week in Maths, we have been finding halves of amounts using bar models. Next week, we will be finding quarters of amounts. We will also start our unit on time. Using clocks, we will make o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to times.

In CCL, the children designed their own flags. They then learnt how to use a running stitch and sewed their design onto a piece of Binca. We have been very impressed with all the children's determination to complete their flags. Next week, the children will be evaluating their flags; what went well and what they found tricky.



In Science, the children have been grouping materials based on shared properties. We used scientific vocabulary to describe the similarities and differences between objects.
