Dear Parents/Carers,


In Literacy this week, we have been focusing on spelling words that include some digraph sounds and some consonant clusters e.g. toast, sleep etc. We have used our robot arms to hear the first, middle and final sounds and then practised writing a sentence of our choice. We practised using a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop at the end.

In Numeracy, we have learnt all about halving and sharing. We have used the method of 'one for me, one for you' and talked about odd and even numbers. We practised using pirate treasure and split it equally onto the treasure chests. We learnt that if one piece of treasure was left over and can't be shared equally then it is an odd number. If the treasure could be shared equally then it is an even number.

As part of our Enquiry Learning this week, we have enjoyed learning all about Father's Day, people who look after us and the special people in our lives. We have made our own special cards by designing the fronts and then writing a special message inside.
