


Friday 18th 2021

Dear Parent / Carer,

In English, we have read the book **Beegu** by Alexis Deacon. We thought of some questions that we would like to ask Beegu about where she came from and how she felt. This enabled us to practise using a question mark and spelling question words. Beegu is an alien who lands on Earth and goes to visit a school but the teacher is unfriendly and unwelcoming – this helped us to learn the ‘un’ prefix! We then decided that we wanted to invite Beegu to Woodhouse. Next week, we will be writing our own letters to invite Beegu to Woodhouse.



In Phonics lessons this week, we have revised all of the Phase 5 sounds and practised reading and spelling words containing these graphemes.



This week in Maths, we have been finding quarters of amounts. We also started a new unit on time. Using clocks, we have made o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to times. We will continue with this next week.

In CCL, the children have been evaluating their flags; what went well and what they found tricky. Next week, we will begin our new topic, ‘Buildings’, by finding out about types and styles of houses. We will also learn about the ways in which homes are adapted to suit different climates around the world. To help us to discuss and explore the types and features of buildings, it would be fantastic if the children could bring a photo of their own home so we can add it to a class display.

In RESPECT, we have been learning about our school value “Be healthy”. The children have sorted healthy and unhealthy foods and explained why some foods are better for us than others.
