In Literacy this week, we have been writing our own 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' stories. We have been thinking carefully about using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We also thought about what type of story language we could use such as 'once upon a time' or 'one day'.

In Numeracy, we have been using number lines to complete addition and subtraction calculations. We practised starting at the biggest number in the calculation and then jumped on or back to find the answer. We know that if it is an addition number sentence we jump up the number line and if it is a subtraction calculation we jump down the number line.


