Unique Ways – Free Courses & Workshops 2021/2022


Unique Ways courses focus on what it means to be a parent of a child with additional needs. The courses cover a mixture of practical skills for things like dealing with professionals or responding to behaviour, as well as some time to look at how it feels to have a child with additional needs and how to build your resilience. All Insiders' Guide courses are a 6-week course, co-delivered by a professional and a parent carer. The courses bring together parents with those who have children of a similar age or those whose children share a particular need.

Classroom News

Year 4 - We have been creating our very own fantasy story. Our story had to include a portal journey and an adventure. We came up with some very creative ideas. In Maths, we have been recapping how to use the grid method for multiplication and then we have been looking at how to use the written method too. In Science, we have been designing headphones for children attending a rock concert to protect their ears from being damaged. We thought about which material would work best for blocking out the sound. In CCL, we have been looking at different people's perspectives on deforestation and thinking about reasons why some people may be for this or against this. On Friday, we will be meeting our Year 2 buddies and helping them design a front cover for their Christmas Celebration performance.

Year 5 - This week, we have started our Christmas unit in English and we have spent some time hot seating the main characters in the story. In Science, as part of our 'humans and living things' topic, we have been learning about David Attenborough and how he has become one of the most important figures in our society. In French, we have enjoyed learning about how Christmas is celebrated in France. Some of the facts we learnt really surprised us!

Year 6 - This week in Geography, we have developed our map reading skills by using both 4 and 6 figure grid references. To consolidate our understanding, we have created our own grid reference map using ordinance survey symbols. We have also enjoyed exploring the local area using digital maps. In Computing, we have been using PowerPoint to create adverts to persuade people to visit France or Germany. We are looking forward to recording our audio for them! In Maths, we have been consolidating our understanding of fractions, decimals and percentages by answering questions in a range of contexts. Reflecting on the story of 'The Christmas Truce,' we have been writing letters to loved ones from the point of view of Jim in our English lessons.
