During English lessons this week, we have written sentences about our 'Elf on the Shelf' and the things he has been doing in the classroom.



In Phonics, our sounds this week have been 'a-e' as in make, 'o-e' as in bone, 'i-e' as in time and 'u-e' as in rude. These graphemes are called split vowel digraphs where one letter goes in between the two vowels. Our tricky words for the week have been: should, could, would, our. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read.

In Maths, we have subtracted using a number line. We have also been finding the difference to solve some basic money problems. Next week, we will begin to look at measuring length.
