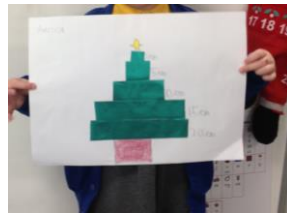
Dear Parent / Carer,

What a fun, festive week we have had! We started the week off with our Christmas party. We played games, danced and enjoyed lots of delicious party food. On Wednesday, we practised our collage skills and created moveable Christmas cards.
