Today we celebrated Red Nose Day by wearing non-uniform and sharing some jokes in class to make each other smile. Thank you for all your kind donations.



In English, we have learnt about verbs (action words) and how we can add the suffix -ed and -ing.

jump – jump<sup>ed</sup> jump<sup>ing</sup>

wish – wish<sup>ed</sup> wish<sup>ing</sup>

We have also read the poem “Colour” by Christina Rossetti. Next week, we will write our own version of the poem choosing different items to represent the colours mentioned in the poem.

This week in Phonics, our sounds have been ‘al’ as in half, ‘tch’ as in match and ‘ture’ as in adventure. Our tricky words for the week have been: eye and because. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read.

In Maths, we have been finding half and a quarter of shapes and explaining how we know if a shape has been halved or split into quarters. We have also been finding half of amounts using bar models. Next week, we will be continuing using the bar model.

In CCL, we have finished stitching our flags. The children have also begun to evaluate their flags by saying what went well and what they found tricky. Next week, we will begin to sort old and new items between two base camps and discuss what it might have been like for an explorer in 1912 compared to a modern-day explorer.
