


Friday 6th May 2022

Dear Parent / Carer,

In English, we have continued our learning linked to the book **Beegu** by Alexis Deacon. Next week, we are going to continue to write a letter to Beegu inviting her to come and visit our friendly school.



This week in Phonics, our sounds have been 'o' as in post, 'o-e' as in stone, 'ie' as in pie and 'i-e' as in stripe. Our tricky words for the week have been: here, says, today, were and one. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read. This week, you all should have received the latest update of your child's progress in Phonics. Any sounds or words marked with a tick or an 'A' means your child knows that sound/word. Words or sounds marked with a dot means we are still practising these.

In Maths, we have been ordering numbers within 100. We have also used the inequality (>, <) symbols to compare 3 and 4 numbers.

$$28 > 20 > 18 > 7$$

$$3 < 8 < 12 < 21$$

Next week, we will begin a new unit on length using non-standard and standard units of measure.

This week, we have started to prepare for our Buildings topic; thank you to everyone who has sent in house photographs and cereal boxes – keep them coming please!
