Dear Parents/Carers,


In Literacy this week, we have been focusing on spelling the phase 3 tricky words. We have talked about how we can't use our segmenting fingers to spell these words and that we just need to know them. We practised reading the tricky words and then covered them up to practise spelling them. We are also focusing on keeping our writing small and neat and sitting the letters on the line. Please help your child to recognise them instantly and to practise the spelling of these words too.

In Numeracy, we have been learning all about taking away and have been using pirate treasure to take away and record take away number sentences. We have used the mathematical vocabulary such as minus and subtract and spoke about how these words mean the same as take away. Next week we will be focusing on doubling and we will be practising adding the same number of butterfly spots onto each wing of the butterfly.

As part of our Enquiry Learning this week, we have enjoyed learning all about our topic of 'Now I am big.' We have enjoyed looking at our baby photographs and have been very busy guessing which baby picture belongs to each child. Next week in enquiry learning we will be learning all about Father's Day and why some people celebrate this special day.
