Dear Parent / Carer,

This week all pupils in Year 1 took part in the Phonics Screening Check. Over the coming weeks, once schools have received notification of the threshold mark, we will let you know whether your child met the required standard. Any pupils who scored below the pass mark will receive additional phonics support in school, before attempting the check again in June 2023.

During Phonics lesson, our focus sounds have been 'wh' as in white, 'ph' as in phone, 'ie' as in shield and 'g' as in giant. Our tricky words for the week have been: once, friend, our, because and laugh. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read.



In Maths, we have been learning about capacity and volume. Using jugs, bottles and containers, we have compared and measured liquids. Next week, we will be starting a new unit on time.

During Science lessons, we have been naming objects and the materials they are made from. The children have been using scientific vocabulary to describe the properties of each material.

In preparation for our trip to Shibden Hall, the children have begun to look at homes through time and how they have changed. We have also started to learn about the Great Fire of London and the significance of this event in history. We will continue with this next week.
