In English this week, we have been using fronted adverbials (sentence openers for time, place and manner) to create a piece of writing focusing on Mildred Hubble's broomstick adventure. Next week, we will be focusing on editing skills before moving on to a short unit on performance poetry.

In Maths, we have been comparing numbers using the language **greater than, less than, equal to** and the related symbols  $<$ ,  $>$  and  $=$ . Next week, we will be ordering numbers with up to 3 digits. The children have now received their TTRockstars log in details which means they can access this exciting platform at home and improve their times tables knowledge whilst joining in with exciting in-class competitions. The log in details have been stuck in the front covers of homework diaries.

In History, as part of our Viking topic, we focused on the means of transport that the Vikings used to travel from Scandinavia- the longship. As well as learning about how longships were designed, we used a range of sources to find out more about what life might have been like for Vikings travelling on the ships.

In Outdoor PE, we are developing our basketball skills and in Indoor PE we have now planned the warm-up and cardio sections of our own fitness videos. We are looking forward to recording these over the coming weeks.
