Firstly, we would like to say a huge thank you to all who attended our Open-Door sessions. It was lovely to see you.

In Phonics, we have recapped the Phase 4 longer words and words containing the new Phase 5 sounds we learnt last week: ay, ou, oy and ea. We have recapped the tricky words: said, says, you, like, little, was, they, some and come.

In Maths this week, we have been comparing sets of numbers to say which has the most, the least, fewer, a greater amount or an equal amount. We have also ordered and sequenced numbers, including the use of ordinal numbers: 1st, 2nd, 3rd.



Next week, we will be locating and comparing digits on a number line.



Geography has been the focus of our CCL this week. We have explored climate, landscape and features within specific areas of Brighouse and Australia, drawing comparisons with our own locality.

As part of our Holidays topic, we will be comparing holiday experiences today and from the past. To help us we would like the children to speak to adults of different generations to find out about their earliest childhood holiday that they can remember!
