



In English this week, we continued to write our own stories for the wordless quest book. Our focus was to write compound sentences using the conjunctions ***when, after, while*** and ***before***.

In Maths, we began by using the column addition method to solve a range of addition problems. We then moved on to using the column subtraction method to subtract 2- and 3-digit numbers.

Our new topic in Science is Forces and Magnets. The children have already conducted an investigation to find out how the force of friction changes depending on the surface.



In RE, we learnt about the celebration of Shabbat. We looked at the events that take place during Shabbat as well as looking at the synagogue and the different artefacts and objects which may be found there.

As a school, we celebrated Anti-Bullying Week this week. In our RESPECT lesson, the children created some bunting which included a range of actions or phrases that can be used to 'reach out'.
