Dear Parents/Carers,

In English this week, we have been using fronted adverbials in our diary entries which were based on our recent trip to York. Now that we are diary writing experts, next week, we will be helping our new friends, Bob Sleigh and Kris Tingle, to keep a diary during their stay here at Woodhouse.



In Maths, we completed a further week on the column subtraction method. We used the method to solve a range of true/false, missing number and word problems. In addition to this, we also looked at fact families and how we can use known facts to support us in answering other calculations. E.G. $35 + 29 = 64$ so $64 - 29 = 35$.

In Geography this week, we recapped on the four points of a compass and then built on this to learn about the eight points. We came up with sentences to help us to remember the order of the points.

In RE, we discussed the Christmas story and then as part of a whole school project, the children created a piece of artwork based on one part of the story. Year 3 focused on when Jesus was born in the stable. We were very impressed with the children's work. 😊
