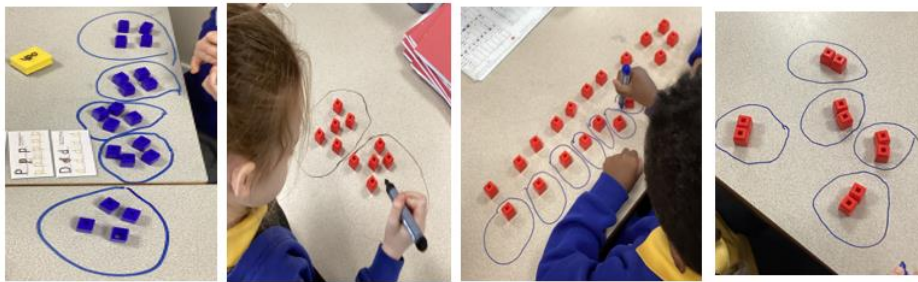

Dear Parent / Carer,

In English, we have been reading fact files about polar animals. As a class, we collected facts about polar bears and organised these into the headings: habitat, diet, appearance and a "did you know?" fact. Next week, we will research Emperor penguins in preparation for the children to write their own fact file.

This week in Phonics, our sounds have been 'se' as in cheese and mouse, 'o' as in brother and 'ce' as in dance. Our tricky words for the week have been: through, thought and friend. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read.

In Maths, we have looked at what equal groups are and what unequal groups are. This will help us to then count in equal groups. This is the first step before we learn to multiply numbers.



We thoroughly enjoyed our trip to Woodhouse Park. While we were there, we put up a flag to show that we had explored the area, just as Christopher Columbus did when he found America. Whilst at the park, we found a polar bear who was lost. He came with a letter asking for our help to find out information about his home. We are going to spend the next couple of weeks learning about the Arctic.
