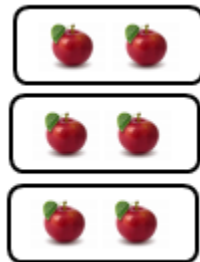
Welcome back!



In CCL, we have been learning about Captain Robert Falcon Scott and the part he played in the race to reach the South Pole first. In our English lessons next week, we will be writing a diary entry from the perspective of Captain Robert Falcon Scott.

This week in Phonics, our sounds have been 'are' as in share, 'u' as in playful, 'oul' as in could, 'or' as in world, 'au' as in astronaut and 'aur' as in dinosaur. Our tricky words for the week have been: oh, once, their, our and laugh. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read.

This week in Maths, we have continued to count rows and columns of equal groups of items. The children have started to use these to show multiplying by 2. Next week, we will continue with learning the 2x table and make connections with doubling numbers.
