

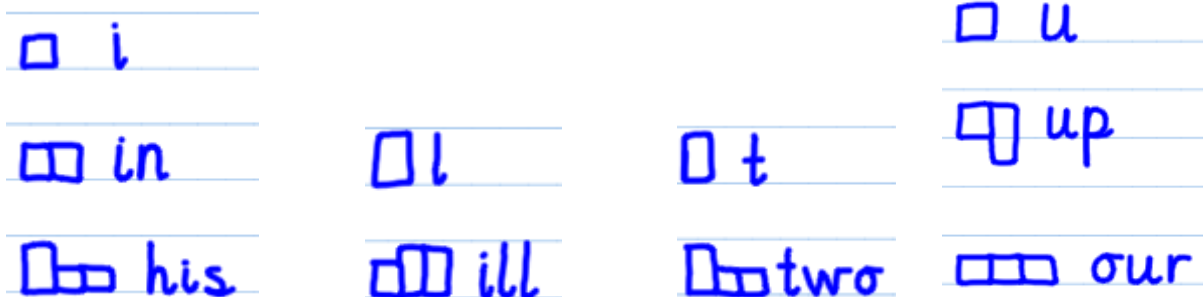
Dear Parent/Carers,

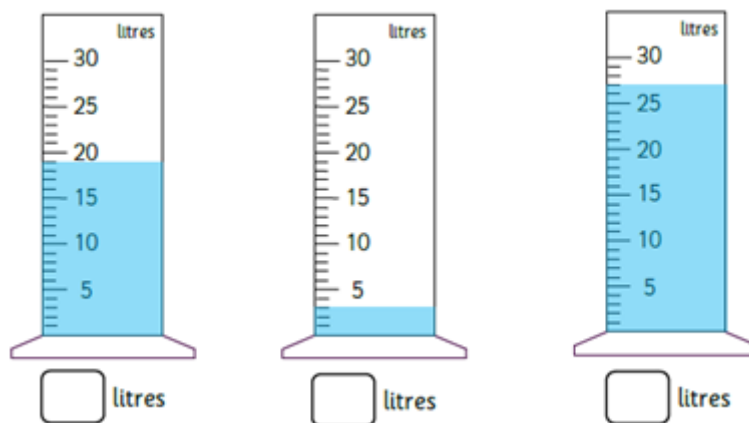

The following letters have been focused on in handwriting lessons this week:



In Maths, we have looked at capacity and learnt how to measure capacity (by using a jug and reading scales of 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s). We started by measuring different amounts of water. If you have a measuring jug at home, perhaps you could take a few minutes to look at the scale and practise measuring some amounts of different liquids.



In RE, we have been thinking about how and why people pray. We have compared different religions and thought about reasons that people may choose to pray. We had a good discussion about prayer and it was great to hear lots of opinions.
