Dear Parents/Carers,

In Literacy this week, we have learnt the sounds **v**, **w**, **x** and **y**. We have learnt to read and spell words such as **yum**, **van**, **win** and **fox**. We have learnt to read the tricky words: **has**, **his** and **her** and recapped the tricky words taught so far.

In Numeracy, the children have been introduced to the concept of one more and one less working with the numbers 1 - 5. We noticed that numbers and amounts increase in value when one more is added and decrease in value when one is taken away. The children were encouraged to answer and ask questions using mathematical vocabulary such as: How many? How many now? What is one more than? What is the number after? What is one less than? What is the number before?





During topic this week we have learnt all about the different nocturnal animals and how they adapt to survive in their environment. We sorted animals into day and night sets. We also enjoyed sharing the stories 'Room on the Broom' and 'Owl Babies' and acted out the 'Owl Babies' story using masks, playing the different roles in the story.
