In English this week, we started a unit on 'letter writing'. We started off by identifying the key features of a letter and then compared two texts to find out which one included the key features and which one didn't. Our focus over the next couple of weeks will be to include fronted adverbials in our letters.

In Maths, we began our multiplication and division unit of work. We looked at how we can use known times table facts to support us when answering trickier multiplication questions. For example – if we know that $3 \times 4 = 12$ then $3 \times 40 = 120$. We also used the greater than, less than and equal to symbols to compare multiplication calculations.

In Computing, the children received an email from the king. The children had to respond with a message and then they had to attach a copy of the quiz which they created last week. The focus of the quiz was 'online safety'.

On Wednesday, all the children took part in our 'No Pens Day: Show and Tell'. We were really impressed with the children's speaking and listening skills. They could talk confidently about something that is special to them, listen to others and ask relevant questions when their peers were sharing their thoughts. Well done, Year 3!
