Dear Parent / Carer,

During English lessons this week, we have started to write our own stories based on the book "Wow! said the Owl" by Tim Hopgood. We were very impressed with the children's ability to write independently. We will be continuing with this next week.

This week in Phonics, we have reviewed all the sounds taught so far. We have checked each child individually to see which sounds they know and which sounds they are still practising. We have sent a copy of this record home in each child's reading packet so we can continue working on these sounds together.

In Maths, we have finished our unit on subtraction and have started our new unit on multiplication. We have been learning to count in the pattern of 2. Using pairs of socks, Numicon and 2 pence coins we have explored how we use counting in twos in everyday life.
