

Dear Parent / Carer,

In Phonics, our sounds this week have been: /y/ as in funny, /ea/ as in bread, /wh/ as in wheel, /oe/ as in toe and /ou/ as in shoulder. Our tricky words for the week have been: any, many and again. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read.

In Science, we have been classifying animals into carnivores, herbivores, and omnivores. We have learnt that carnivores eat meat, herbivores eat plants and omnivores eat both meat and plants.

In DT, we have been selecting ingredients for a recipe. We chose different fruits to taste and decided on three ingredients we would like to use when making our smoothie next week.
