Dear Parents/Carers,

In English this week, we used the skills that we have learnt to write a letter to our friends. Some of us wrote about what Santa gets up to on Christmas Eve and some of us wrote about other celebrations within the year.

In Maths, we continued to practise the grid method for multiplication and then solved a range of problems using this method. Practising times tables as much as possible will support your child's fluency and accuracy when solving multiplication and division calculations. By the end of Year 3, it is hoped that children can recall multiplication and division facts for the x2, x10, x5, x3, x4, x6, x8 tables fluently.

We would like to remind you that the Year 3 Christmas party will take place on Tuesday afternoon next week – you will have received some information about this earlier on in the week. Your child should come to school in their school uniform and there will be an opportunity to change into party clothes in the afternoon.
