


Dear Parent / Carer,

This week in Phonics, we have learnt the sound “ui” as in fruit and ‘ou’ as in soup. We have also recapped all of the sounds covered this half term (wh, oe, y, ea, ow, ve, ph, ou, ey, se, ce, le). Our tricky words for the week have been: who, many, two, school, friend. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read.

In Maths, we have looked at what equal groups are and what unequal groups are. This will help us to then count in equal groups. This is the first step before we learn to multiply numbers.



In Geography, we identified the four compass directions and used them to describe the location of landmarks. We now know the four compass directions are north, east, south and west. We know the arrow on a compass always points north.

In Art this week, our focus has been printing with paint. Using Lego, we painted and stamped blocks to create patterns, pictures and letters. We combined primary colours on the page by overlapping prints, to create secondary colours.
