

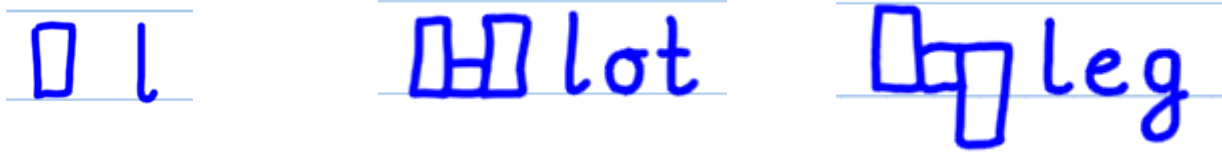

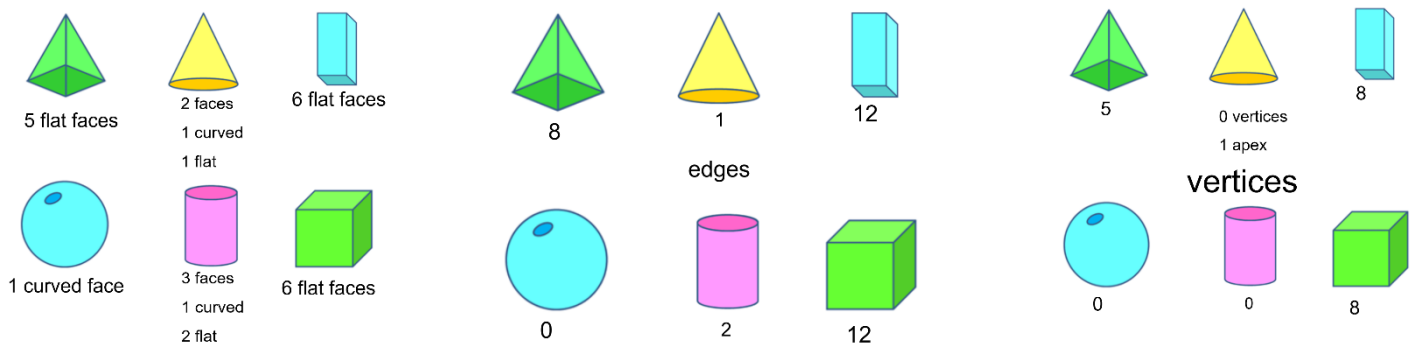
In English this week, we have created our own version of the story 'Ganesh Gets Married'. This included changing the main settings in the story which also impacted who our main character interacted with on the journey around the world. We have added tension and mood to our writing by using short, sharp interruptions with short sentences and also description using exciting adjectives.

In year 2 we are spending a lot of time checking for the correct letter formation when marking the children's handwriting. Below is an example of how tall, short and hanging letters should be formed on a line.



The children are trying hard to make it very clear, which letters are tall, short or hanging. This is a year 2 skill that all children need to be able to demonstrate consistently, before the end of the year. We are focusing on handwriting in every piece of writing, even if the children are just writing their names on their work. If we could please ask that your child continues to focus on correct letter formation when completing any writing at home. This consistent expectation would be greatly appreciated.

In Maths, we have looked at the properties of 3d shape. We recapped the names of the shapes and discussed how many faces, edges and vertices they had. Being able to recall these shape properties off by heart is a year 2 requirement so please continue to encourage your child with learning and remembering these facts.
