In Phonics, our sounds this week have been 'a' as in <u>a</u>corn, 'e' as in <u>fe</u>ver, 'i' as in <u>fi</u>nd and 'o' as in <u>bo</u>th. Our tricky words for the week have been: Mr, Mrs, Ms and ask. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read.

In Maths, we have continued to explore the 'Part Whole Model' to partition (split up) numbers in various ways. We are becoming much more confident in writing two addition facts that can be represented using this model.



After the holidays we will be learning about the pairs to 10 and looking at different ways we can represent them using ten frames, part whole models and number sentences.
